Founded in 1940 by Brother Roger Schultz, the Taizé community is a community of Catholic and Protestant brothers from a variety of backgrounds and nations with a mission of healing and reconciliation. The daily life of the Taizé community is centered in communal prayer which includes scripture readings, psalms and meditative singing. Our program on the 4th Thursday of each month will include music from Taizé: a song with a few words of faith, repeated again and again, that provide a way to enter more deeply into the presence of God in community with one another.
