## Vatican sets new catechetic norms

ROME - NC - By definition, catechetics is the use of questions and answers to teach the faith.

The Vatican issued at a nevs conference June 17 a general catechetical directory that Fatses questions and tries to supply some of the answers to the complex problems of teaching the faith in a jet-age world.

VATICAN CITY - (NC) - Pope Paul VI has reaffirmed brief moment of celebration of the Lord's Sacrificial the ancient law that persons who have lost the state of grace receiving Communion

There are some today who attempt to exempt the faithful from this indispensable condition," he observed at a general audience.
"But are those who dispense themselves of it 'faithful"? he asked.

Pope Paul quoted St. Paul's warning in his letter to the Corinthinans: "Whoever eats this Bread or drinks the Cup of Lhe Lord unworthily will be guilty of the Body and Blood of the Lord.

THE Pope commented: "It is necessary to have a pure soul; it is necessary to have recovered grace through Penance - the sacrament of rehabilitation - before approaching Christ's embrace.
He also reaffirmed the val

He also reaffirmed the validity of devotion to the Blessed Sacrament outside Mass
"Eucharistic piety has an extension greater than the

Supper, " the Pope asserted.

The Lord remains in the sacramental species, and this permanence not only justifies but demands its own cut not possible during Mass, and the solemn procession that will be the rite proper to tomorrow's feast.

Referring to the institution in the 13th century of the Feast of Corpus Christi, which focuses on the sacrament of the Eucharist without the sad overtones of holy Thursday, the Pope said:
the feast not be surprised at the belated institution of an sacrament.

It testifies to the Church's progressive awareness of the treasures of truth and grace which it carries within itself, and the growing charity with which it responds to the great and mysterious divine gitt. The Church always had faith in the presence of Christ in the sacramental species even beyond and outside the celebration of the Eucharistic sacrifice**

Formation of the new parishes brings to a total of 119 the parish communties now served by more than 400 priests who are diocesan clergy and members of religious orders.

WHEN the Archdiocese of Miami was established May. 1968 a Catholic population of almost 400,000 was served in the cight counties by 85 parishes and 306 priests.

Today, according to statistics published by the Official Catholic Directory of 1971, the Catholic population in South Florida has increased to 556.466 .

In addition. 53 Brothers and 563 Sisters teach in schools of the Archdiocese as well as 1.854 lay teachers.

The Archdiocese has more than 12 seminarians residence lor semior citizens if conducted in Pompato studying lor the priesthoow at St John Warney Semi- Beach and another is under cotstruction al wiand nary. Miam: and at the Seminary of St Vitcent de Beach.

## A remarkable era

The recent tormation，by Archbishop Coleman F Carroll．of five new parishes in the Archdiocese of Miami certainly mirrors a remarkable era in the history of the Church in South Florida，which has grown to a total population of 556.466 ．

On Aug．is，1088，when the Diocesc of Mam was estabished by Pope Pius XII．the territorial himits in－ chded 16 South Florida counties．eight of which have now been included in the Dioceses of St．Petersbure and Ortando．

AT THE TIME 65 diocesan priests served in 51
ishes and institutions of the diocese and nine reli－ parishes and instutuons of the whocese and nue reln＊ diocese had five contral Catholic high schools．one novitiate and one college within its boundaries．

## 'Game players' try to bend new social document

That is to say, in this country at cast. most commentators on the Apostolic Letter are happy about the fact that the Pope has prudently refrained from trying to universat answers to problems which, though they may be common to all mankind. neverthey may be common to all mankind. never-
theless tend to take on different forms in difheless tend to take on dinerent orms in dierent regions of the word and, for that ceason, ean only be solved in the
THE PRNCIPLE, thens.
THE PRINCIPLE, then. is very sound. local solutions to local problems analyzed moral standards and with due attention being given to the situation which prevails in each particular region or nation or locality.
So far so good. The problem, fowever, is this, that local groups of Christians, despite deliberately refrained from trying to suggest, much less impose, his own top-down solutions to regional or local problems, will almost inevitably try to read such solutions into the text of the Apostolic Letter and will try to demonstrate, by citing chapter and verse, that the Holy Father is definitely on their side in this or that particular local controversy.
As a matter of fact, this process of attempting to use the Apostolic Letter in an
effort to score debaters' points against the effort to score debaters' points against the
opposition in local controversies is aiready opposition in local controversies is already

Three or four Catholic papers in this ountry, for example, having analyzed the Apostolic Letter with what they undoubtedly regard as complete objectivity, have concluded, to their own satisfaction. that the document condemns and rejects every conpapers headined its front-page story on the etter: "Pope Flays Socialism." Some of he others have made the same point with just a bit more (but not much more) subtlety and sophistication

ICI has sampled the reaction of the European press - both the Catholic and the general press - to the Apostolic Letter. Again we find differen papers reating arguing in effect that the pope is on their side of this or that current controversy in their respective countries - or, in some cases, criticizing the pope for not being on their side.

WTH REGARD to the latter point. ICl reports that the right-wing press in ltaly (which one would have to read rather carefully over a period of time to see how bad it really is was deeply embarrasolitical reasons. We are told that, in general, this section of the Italian press completely ignored or passed over the Pope's so-called "opening to the left" and his refusal to hand down directives in the political order and
concentrated instead on his criticism of the concentrated ins
Marxist ideology.

Needless to add, the left-wing press in Italy took the opposite tack and underined or concentrated on those sections of the Apostolic Letter in which the Pope tells about the "plurality" of social and political options which are open to Christians and about the evolution which the various types of socialism are undergoing.

The ICI article reports that papers in other European countries have also divided. roughly along the same lines as the Italian
papers, in the Letter. That is ${ }^{t} e^{\prime}$ say. different papers have read different i zanings into the document, presumably with the hope of suggesting. though not actually being able to prove, that the Pope is on their side - meaning, of course, the side of the angels.

LEAMINGTON SPA, England - (NC) - A new as its pornice Britain has chosen the spread of abortions in Great Britain.

Life, an organization fomded by Prof. Jokn Scarisbrick, a Catholic lecturer in history at Warwick Universify, has set up a 24 -hour telephone answering service designed to dissuade pregnat women from baving abortions.

Abortions in Britain are estimated to be raming cerrently at the rate of 800,000 a year

WOMEN with doubts about abortions can tefephone the numbers listed and speak to counselor who are "mature married women with children of their own," Prof. Scarisbrick said.
"We will put women considering an abortion in touch with social services who can belp her have her child, " he said.

When the women already have large families and say they cannot afford children Life suggests adoption because it contends this would make a couple who were unable to have children very happy.

At the moment the service is operated from two telephone numbers in Leamington Spa, Prof. Scaris brick's home town, but there are plans for extending it to other areas.
