FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

Q. When are tuition and fee payments due?

A. Tuition and fees are due by the specified due dates for the corresponding term you are registered in. Refer to the Academic Calendar for specific dates.

Q. Where can I make my payment(s)?

A. You can pay online at **go.stu.edu/pay** or login to Mybobcat. Payments can also be mailed, or pay in person at the Business Office on campus. Wire transfer information is available at **www.stu.edu/businessoffice**; click on the link FAQ.

Q. What methods of payment do you accept?

A. We accept cash, checks, money orders, cashier's checks or credit cards (Visa, MasterCard, Discover). We do not accept American Express.

Q. What can stop me from receiving transcripts?

A. Unpaid balances on your student account, past due Perkins loan payments, and incomplete exit counseling. If your account does not reflect a zero balance, you will not be able to receive your transcripts.

Q. What do I need to do to have Florida Prepaid College Program billed for my tuition?

A. If you are a freshman or first time participant, you must complete a Transfer Authorization form and mail it to the address on the form. For more information contact Florida Prepaid at 1-800-552-4723.

Q. I paid for my classes but then dropped them prior to the Add/Drop deadline, how and when will this money be refunded to me?

A. Refunds are processed via direct deposit within fourteen (14) days after a credit balance appears on the student account.

Q. I added a class after the class started, is there a fee for adding the class late?

A. If a course is added after the Add/Drop deadline a $10\$ fee will be assessed.
