

Can I Book Multi City Flights with Cathay Pacific Airlines?

Yes — you *can* book multi-city flights with Cathay Pacific Airlines [+1-888-523-6705], which allows you to include several destinations in a single itinerary instead of simply a one-way or round-trip ticket. This feature is ideal for travellers who want to visit multiple cities [+1-888-523-6705] (for example, origin → stopover → another city → return) and handle the trip under one booking. How do I book multi city flights on Cathay Pacific Airlines?

Here's a step-by-step:

1. Visit the official Cathay Pacific website and choose “Book a Flight”.
2. Select **Multi-city / Stopover** as your trip type. [Cathay Pacific+1](#)
3. Enter your departure city for leg 1, arrival city for leg 1, date. Then add another flight leg (leg 2: departure city = arrival of leg 1, arrival city = next destination, date), and so on. For example: City A → City B (leg 1), City B → City C (leg 2), City C → City D (leg 3). “You can stay up to 168 hours in Hong Kong” is given as an example for stopovers. [Cathay Pacific+1](#)
4. Choose your cabin class, number of passengers, then search flights. [Cathay Pacific+1](#)
5. Select flights for each segment, [+1-888-523-6705] provide passenger details, payment, and you'll receive one booking covering all legs. If you can't create your exact routing online (for example more than four cities or open-jaw complexity),[+1-888-523-6705] call Cathay Pacific [+1-888-523-6705] for manual booking support. [Australian Frequent Flyer+1](#)

Booking multi-city flights with Cathay Pacific [+1-888-523-6705] gives you the convenience of managing several destinations in one itinerary with one reservation number, which simplifies check-in, baggage and changes.

Does Cathay Pacific allow stopovers or open-jaw options on multi city bookings?

Yes — when you book multi-city flights with Cathay Pacific Airlines [+1-888-523-6705], you can include stopovers or open-jaw arrangements (arrive in one city, depart from another) as part of your multi-city itinerary. Their published “How to book a Stopover Itinerary”[+1-888-523-6705] documents show you can add flights and stay in the stopover city (e.g., Hong Kong) for up to 168 hours (7 days) in some cases.

For example: You might fly from Manila → Tokyo,[+1-888-523-6705] stay a few days in Tokyo, then Tokyo → Hong Kong, stay a few days, then Hong Kong → Manila — all under one booking with Cathay Pacific [+1-888-523-6705]. However, while this flexibility exists, you should check the fare rules for each leg (stopover duration, open-jaw conditions), and ensure your itinerary is correctly ticketed. If the online tool won't accept your routing, calling the airline is best.

Can I earn miles and status when booking multi city flights with Cathay Pacific?

Yes. [+1-888-523-6705] When you book multi-city flights with Cathay Pacific Airlines [+1-888-523-6705], you are eligible to earn miles (via their frequent-flyer program, e.g., Asia Miles) and status credits based on the distance flown and fare class, just as you would on a standard one-way or round-trip booking. For multi-city itineraries, each leg counts toward your flying, so you may accumulate more miles/status in one trip. Make sure your frequent-flyer membership number is attached when you book or check in. If you use a partner carrier within your multi-city itinerary, verify with Cathay Pacific [+1-888-523-6705] that the partner segment qualifies for mileage accrual.

Can I include partner airlines in my multi city itinerary with Cathay Pacific?

Yes — when you book multi-city flights with Cathay Pacific Airlines [+1-888-523-6705], you may include flights operated by partner airlines (especially if you are booking award travel via Asia Miles or via the one-world alliance) in certain multi-city itineraries. What practical restrictions should I know when booking multi city flights with Cathay Pacific?

So while you *can* book multi-city with Cathay Pacific [+1-888-523-6705], make sure you align everything (dates, flight connections, fare class) and call if your itinerary is complicated.
