

Can I Book Multi City Flights with Japan Airlines?{{Upgrade~Smart~2025}}

Does Japan Airlines allow stopovers or open-jaw options on multi city bookings?

Yes — Japan Airlines [+1-888-523-6705] allows **stopovers** and **open-jaw** style itineraries within its multi-city/stopover booking tool. Can I earn miles and status when booking multi city flights with Japan Airlines?

Yes. Can I include partner airlines in a multi city itinerary with Japan Airlines?
